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# Unemployment Duration

## Why are unemployment durations so high?

- 1. Job Market Mismatches: Some argue that much of the U.S. unemployment is associated with geographical, occupational and educational attainment mismatches.**
  - a. Middle skills argument – skill shortage**
  - b. Geographic mismatch – associated with diminished mobility.**



# Unemployment Duration

**Why are unemployment durations so high?**

**2. Labor market disincentives from unemployment insurance (especially extended benefits programs).**

- a. These benefits exert powerful influence on an individuals willingness to work.**
- b. Unemployment insurance raises reservation wages.**

# **Impact of Unemployment Insurance Incentives on unemployment.**

- **There is a wide range of estimates on extended benefits and their effects on the unemployment rate.**
  - 1. Valletta and Kuang – 99 weeks of benefits raise the unemployment rate by 0.4 percentage points.**
  - 2. Fujita – 99 weeks of benefits raise the unemployment rate by 1.2 percentage points.**
  - 3. Ruthstein – 99 weeks of benefits raise the unemployment rate by 0.2 percentage points.**

**Why are unemployment durations so high?**

**3. Discrimination against unemployed workers.**

- a. Employers screen out unemployed workers before the interview process.**
- b. Discrimination against other demographic groups (especially disabled).**

# Unemployment Duration

**Why are unemployment durations so high?**

- 4. Jobs Deficit: Not enough hiring taking place.**
  - a. Dwindling demand for labor means that the level of aggregate demand is insufficient relative to the quantity of job seekers.**

# Unemployment Duration

## Why are unemployment durations so high?

5. **The long-term unemployed become “stale.” Unemployment appears to be path dependent: the probability of finding work decreases the longer a worker is unemployed.**
  - a. **The intensity of the job search appears to slow as the duration of unemployment rises.**
  - b. **Workers lose skills during periods of long-term unemployment.**




