Short description of the type of training planned and type of participants targeted:
Workforce Development Council Snohomish County is hoping to submit a proposal to the U.S. Department of Labor in response to SGA/DFA PY 08-21, Green Capacity Building Grants, as a current YouthBuild grantee. In concert with out community colleges and other partners, we are exploring equipping a new classroom in North Snohomish County to offer integrated academic and green construction industry training. This classroom will serve as a base of operations for the classroom-based training component of our YouthBuild Program which will operate in rural Stanwood. It will also be available to serve Members participating in our ARRA AmeriCorps program who will be working with Snohomish County and their Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) and other weatherization programs and with Housing Hope on their USDA Self-Help Housing Program for low-income families. These classes will benefit the energy-efficient building, construction, and retrofit industries as well as the energy efficiency assessment industry serving residential, commercial, and industrial industries. We plan to make the classroom available to other programs and partners serving North Snohomish County as needed and available.
